TV Set Up

Quick Start Guide

The TV will display 'no signal' until it has been tuned in.

Turn TV on by pressing power.
Then, using 'select' choose the TV channel. A 'DVB-T' screen saver should be displayed.
If it isn't, turn the TV on and off at the mains.




Press 'menu' to bring up the DVB-T menu screen, as shown here.

Using ▼ move to select and press 'OK'. Press OK again to select Auto Scan. Check settings are correct, as shown opposite, then navigate down To 'Search' and press 'OK'.



All available programs will be displayed on TV/radio window.

Press OK to save or exit to quit.



^{*} Tip - to display Radio Channels press TV/Radio

Remote Control

Please note the remote is a 2-part remote. All functions in the top half control the TV functions. The bottom half of the remote controls the DVB-T tuner.

MENU

Used to access menu options for picture quality adjustment, channel scan, and return to original factory setting

When press menu button, it will be menu navigation down button

When press menu button, it will be menu navigation up button

Number Keys(0~9)

For direct entry of channel number or input of alphanumeric characters
System Information

MENU

Access the DVB-T main menu

OK

Select an item or confirms a choice. List will enter the channel manager



Under DVB-T mode, move the left or right item in the menu

EPG(Electronic Program Guide)

Call up the EPG function Switching TV and AV

Fav

Select the favorite or all DVB-T channels

INFC

Displays information on viewed channel (DVB-T mode)

TV/TXT

DOES NOT FUNCTION as this TV does Not have Teletext.



POWER

LCD monitor power button (On/Off)

X

Mute setting

SELECT

Switching Video source

VOLUME+-

Change the degree of volume

CHANNEL▲▼

Change channels sequentially up or own in viewing mode

EXIT

To return to previous status or exit

RECALL

Goes back to the previously viewed channel

SCAN

Scan TV channel.

AV

Under DVB-T mode, change channels sequentially up or down in viewing mode

PaliP


Move up a page in the channel list of DVB-T

PgDn

Move down a page in the channel list of DVB-T


TV/RADIO

Switches between TV and AV mode



Replace battery





1. Open the battery cap

Turn around the battery cap to the open mark, and take the battery out from the base (See figure 1)

2. Replace battery

Ensure the anode (Positive) and cathode (Negative) are correct.

Note: Do not lose the waterproof rubber seal

3. Close the battery cap

Turn around the battery cap to the close mark (See figure 3)

DVB-T MENU LIST – Remote Control (Button MENU)

Channel Manager

Channel manager

Choose "channel manager" and select "TV Channel" or "Radio Channel".



TV Channel

Select "ALL" to see all available channels.

Favorite TV Channel

Select "Favorite" to show favorite channel in the window

Favorite

Select "ALL" to get all channels, then move to "Favorite" in the operation list and press OK. Use up/down to select the channel. Press OK, the "F" will appear and the channel is selected as a favorite channel. Press OK again to "Cancel" or press "EXIT" to save it.

Move

Select "Move" option and press "OK", select channel and press "OK" to move. Press "▲ ▼ " button to move it to the position where you want. Press "EXIT" to save it.









Delete

Select "Delete", to go channel list and press "▼ ▲" button to choose channel press OK to delete.



Radio Channel

All set up and operation is the same as in TV Channel.



EPG

EPG

*Select "Program list" and press "OK" to enter sub menu.

*Press "EPG" key on remote to select advanced or simple EPG.




Advanced EPG

Press "▲ ▼" button to check one week of new schedule on TV channels.



Simple EPG

Press "▲ ▼"button to check current and next broadcasting program and timing.



General Precautions

- 1. Do not add any parts or use any accessories not provided from the manufacturer.
- 2. Temperature. (Storage 0~70, Operating 0~65) degrees C.
- 3. Make sure Anode (Positive) and Cathode (Negative) are correctly connected. It might damage your LCD if connecting wrong electrode.
- 4. Please replace new battery immediately when the battery runs out. The life of battery is one year.
- 5. The TV is waterproof IP67. This is fully waterproof, however, we would not suggest submerging in water.
- 6. Whilst the remote control is waterproof, we would not suggest floating it in water. It is recommended to dry the remote after use.
- 7. Clean the unit with a soft damp cloth. Do not use abrasive substances or materials that could scratch the glass panel
